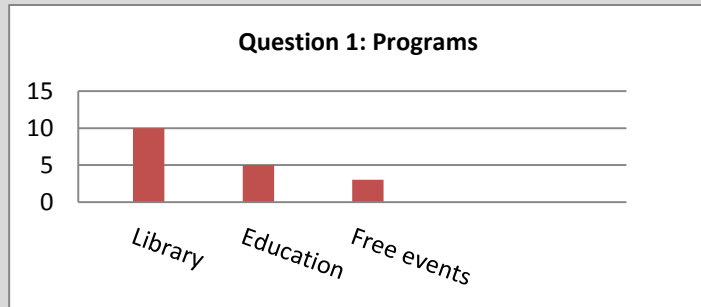

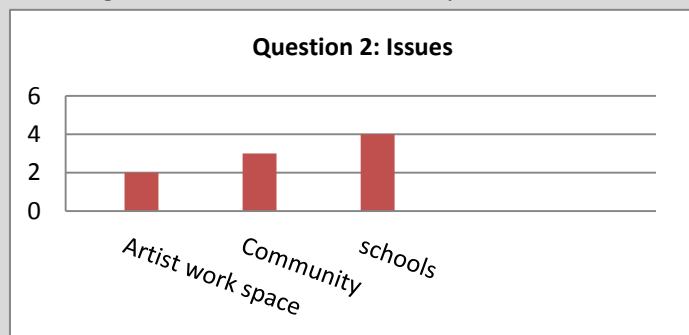
1. What current arts and cultural programs or services are important to maintain?

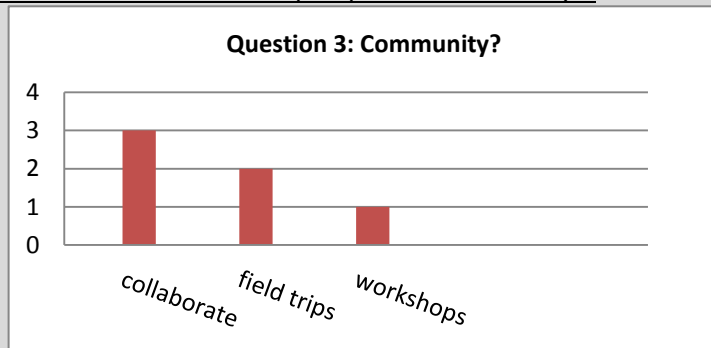
2. What do you consider to be important issues relating to culture in our community?

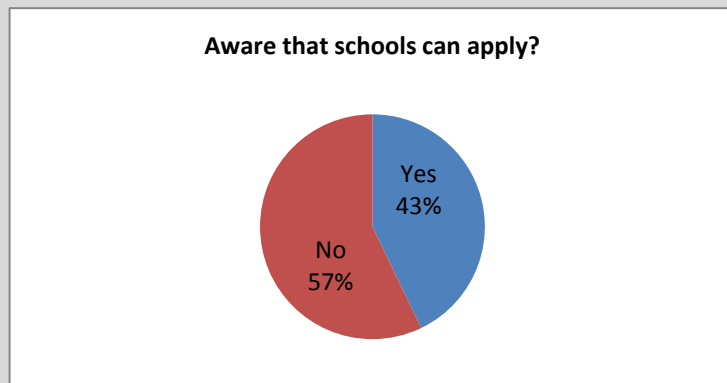
3. What might artists and arts organizations do to make ours a more prosperous community?

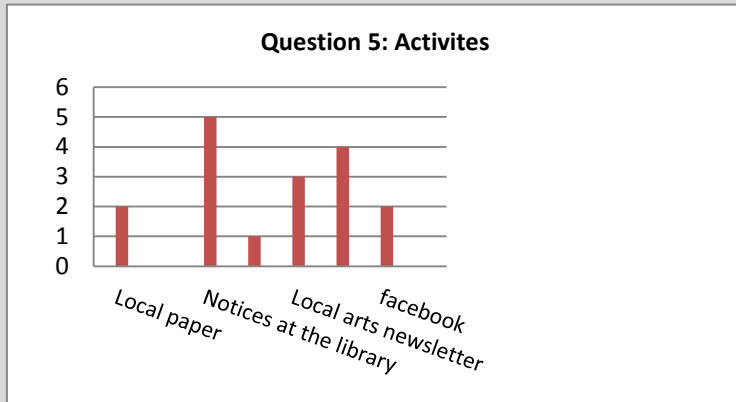
4. Were you aware that artists, schools and community groups can apply for grants?

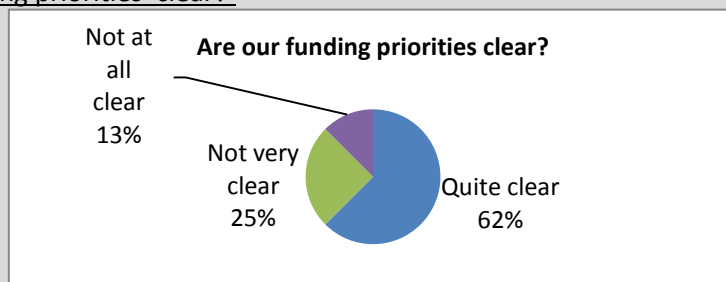
5. How do you hear about cultural activities that interest you?

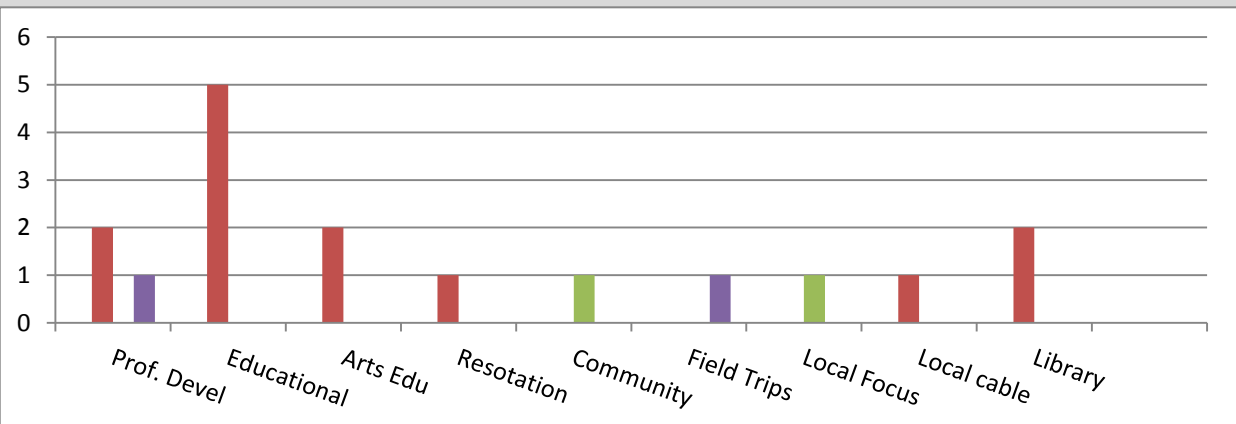
6. Do you believe we have made our funding priorities clear?

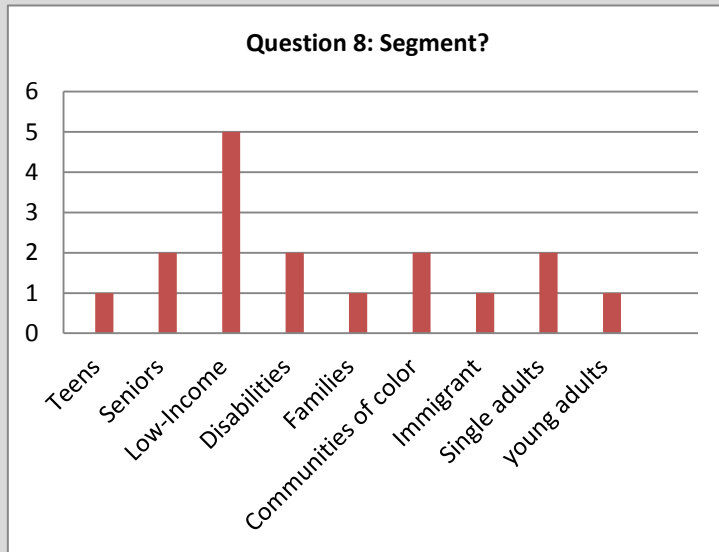

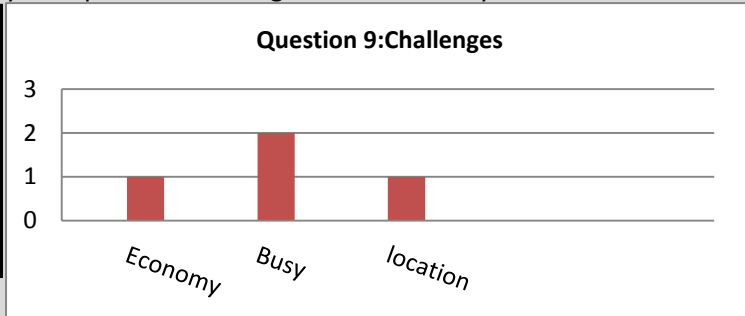
